JOSEF FRANK DESIGNED Dining Table 884 in 1938. To mix different materials was typical for Josef Frank's design. Here an exciting mix with a tabletop in lacquered linoleum and walnut, an iron base with brass feet endings. The table has two extension leaves and can be extended to a total of 295 cm. The table can expand without stabilizers.

MATERIAL Tabletop in lacquered linoleum and walnut. Base in iron and brass. The table comes with two extension leaves that are kept inside the table.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood and then lacquered. The woodwork should be cleaned simply with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Make sure to dry it with a soft cloth.

Furniture with a linoleum surface should be carefully wiped with a soft and clean microfiber cloth. If necessary, wipe with a mild soapy water and then dry the surface.

Polish, oil or abrasive cleaners should never be used on the furniture. Never expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat. Never place a vase filled with water directly on the table as water-filled vases can cause condensation and damage the surface. Keep in mind that corrosion can occur on the iron base if the varnish is damaged.
