



DINING TABLE À TABLE

INTERIOR ARCHITECT AND DESIGNER JONAS BOHLIN grew up with Josef Frank's material world and sees À Table as a contemporary interpretation with inspiration from Josef Frank's designs. The table has a white-pigmented ash top, a white-lacquered iron underside, leather-wrapped details and brass feet. When designing, Bohlin always has a 100-year perspective and Swedish material and craftsmanship are a matter of course – something that corresponds well with Svenskt Tenn's long-term perspective and company culture.

DINING TABLE À TABLE

MATERIAL Powder-coated iron, oiled ash, Tärnsjö natural leather, details of brass and stainless steel.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood and then lacquered. The woodwork should be cleaned simply with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Make sure to dry it with a soft cloth.

Polish, oil or abrasive cleaners should never be used on the furniture. Never expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat. If an injury in the paint or wood occurs, you should immediately contact a furniture restorer. Often you can restore easier damage, but the damage is likely to worsen if not taken care of. Never move the furniture by dragging it across the floor.

The furniture lacquer can be damaged by direct heat and lengthy exposure to dampness. Keep in mind that water-filled vases can cause condensation.

Colour variations can occur if parts of the tabletop or other wood surfaces on furniture are covered early on with, for example, books or other items. It is therefore recommended that you not put vases or placemats and the like, on the tabletop for some time when the furniture is new. This will enable the wood to age evenly over a period of time. Avoid exposing your furniture to large changes in temperature and humidity, which can significantly affect natural movements of the wood.

The coated leg's can be harmed by direct contact with heat and prolonged humidity. Never leave water or other liquids to dry by themselves on the surface as this can miscolour it or cause calcium deposits. Scratches can be extra visible on colour-coated surfaces, but at the same time, these are also part of the table's character. If there is deeper damage to the metal, we recommend you to contact an expert to avoid corrosion.
