ARMCHAIR 652 WAS DESIGNED by Josef Frank in 1936 and three years later, it was used at the Golden Gate Exhibition in San Francisco. This elegant armchair has a high openwork back of rounded spindles joined by a crossbar, which creates a geometrically airy design. Josef Frank often mixed different types of wood and material for an exciting design.

MATERIAL Frame of cherry. The seat is made in plaited webbing with foam/synthetic padding. The clad details can be lined with dubbel ribbon alternatively nails.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood that is varnished or coated. Clean with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Dry with a soft cloth. Do not expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat or use polish, oil or abrasive cleaners on the furniture.

Contact a furniture restorer if the coating or wood gets damaged, as it can get worse if not tended to.
