THIS STOOL WAS DESIGNED by Josef Frank in 1936 to go with Armchair 568. The generous cushioned seat and the tapered legs are typical of Josef Frank's designs.

MATERIAL Wooden frame. Core of coil springs on a no-sag spring base, stuffed with foam rubber/polyether and synthetic batting. Cushion of synthetic fibre/feathers in downproof cases with nonremovable fabric covers. 8-angular legs of stained beech.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS Feather cushions are sewn in one section and uniquely assembled to provide the best possible seating comfort. All types of feather cushions need to be puffed up to maintain their resilience. Shake and puff up the cushions regularly and knead them to loosen up any feather bunches.

The legs are screwed on and may need to be tightened from time to time. For additional protection we recommend ordering extra covers for the armrests.
