LIGHTNESS AND ELEGANCE often characterise Josef Frank's furniture. This is also the case with this stool, with legs that end in rounded feet. Josef Frank's inspiration for this stool, designed in the late 1940s, came from England and the Queen Anne style of the 1700s.

MATERIAL: Walnut with seat in rattan/leather.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS: Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood that is varnished or coated. Clean with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Dry with a soft cloth. Do not expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat or use polish, oil or abrasive cleaners on the furniture.

Contact a furniture restorer if the coating or wood gets damaged, as it can get worse if not tended to.

Never place the stool with leather seat closer than 20-30 cm to a radiator or in direct sunlight. Vacuum clean leather often with a soft brush and, when necessary, clean any exposed surfaces. For stains that are water-soluble, dampen the area and dry using a paper towel. Never use strong solvents or chemicals. Leather is a living material that matures beautifully if treated properly.

Clean the rattan seat with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Dry with a soft cloth. Do not expose rattan to prolonged humidity or direct heat or use polish, oil or abrasive cleaners on the furniture.
