





## MIRROR FAUNA

EVER SINCE GRADUATING from Konstfack University of Arts and Design in 2011, John Astbury has been part of the international design scene. The mirror Fauna creates with its inclined mirror an architectural element that captures the reflections of the mirror's frame and at the same time invites the room around it. The myth "Fauna of Mirrors" which tells of a world of creatures that exist hidden behind every mirror and the idea of an extra dimension reflected in the mirror, inspired Astbury naming the mirror after the saga. Material choices are simple but at the same time solid and creates a geometric play on the eye. Designed exclusively for the Svenskt Tenn in 2014.

## MIRROR FAUNA

MATERIAL Powder coated steel, mirror and foot of travertine.

**CARE INSTRUCTIONS** To clean the frame, use a soft cloth dampened with a mild detergent or soapy water. Make sure to wipe the surface dry immediately. Dry in the direction of the material's grain.

Lacquered or coated pieces can be harmed by direct contact with heat and prolonged humidity. Never leave water or other liquids to dry by themselves on the surface as this can miscolour it or cause calcium deposits. Scratches can be extra visible on colour-coated surfaces, but at the same time, these are also part of the mirror's character. If there is deeper damage to the metal, we recommend you to contact an expert to avoid corrosion.
