DESIGNER: JOSEF FRANK, 1947

In Josef Frank's rattan Chair 1184, the angular carpentry that is often found in wooden chairs is replaced by soft turns and moulded curves. The shape clearly illustrates the technical nature of rattan. The lathe back has the same design as in Josef Frank's Chair 1165 and represents a recurring basket weaving pattern. Chair 1184 was designed around 1947 and is made today at Larsson Korgmakare in Stockholm.
